

## Erratum – Please amend the Report

### “Mozambique: Independent Evaluation of the PAPs' Performance in 2009 and Performance Trends in the Period 2004-2009”

1. In the second sentence of the last paragraph on page 3: “*The remaining five maintained their positions*” **replace** “five” **with** “seven”.
2. In paragraph 4.3 (page 24) on the performance of the African Development Bank (ADB) **replace** the last two sentences, “*The ADB has received 19 out of 36 possible points, i.e. 53%. This deterioration in performance by 2 percentage points means that the ADB has worsened, albeit slightly, its already weak performance*” **with** “The ADB has received 21 out of 36 possible points, i.e. 58%, an improvement of 3 percentage points in its performance in relation to the previous year”.
3. In table 4.3 (page 26) relating to the summary of ADB's performance by indicator, **replace** the 0 in the column of points assigned to ADB's performance in the indicator 18, regarding the number of parallel Project Implementation Units **with** a 2. In the same table, **substitute** the total score of 19 **with** 21.
4. In paragraph 4.10 (page 34) on the individual performance of Spain, **delete** the last two sentences: “*However, it should be noted that Spain was the PAP which has a greater reduction in the amounts of aid to the country. This reduction – almost U.S. \$ 30 million (approximately 70%) – is not focused on aid to the government, which increased by about U.S. \$ 5 million (approximately 30%)*”. This correction is due to the fact that Spain has maintained its total amount of aid to the country.
5. In table 4.20 (page 48) relating to the general ranking of the PAPs by points, **replace** the number 13, corresponding to the position of France and the World Bank, **with** number 14.
