

## **Justice and Legality Sector coordination**

### **Donor Working Group on Justice and Legality (DWG/JL)**

#### **Terms of Reference**

##### **Objective**

To contribute to the development of Justice and Legality through dialogue and coordination of initiatives among bilateral and multilateral donors active in the Justice and Legality sector.

##### **Tasks**

The Donor Working Group on Justice and Legality will perform the following tasks:

- Information sharing
  - Share information on relevant policies, legal and institutional changes and external support programmes
  - Provide feed-back on relevant information to the DPG and/or G17/PAP
- Coordination
  - Produce and update an annual inventory (map) of existing projects and programmes
  - Maintain links with other sector-related working groups (ex. governance Task Force, public sector reform group, decentralization, anti-corruption, ad-hoc elections group, audit group)
  - Participate in the preparation of government-international partners events (Joint Review, MYR, Consultative Group, etc.)

##### **Participants**

The group will be chaired by the focal donor and be composed of:

- Bilateral and multilateral donors contributing to the sector
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- By other interested partners dealing with Rule of Law issues on an “ad hoc” basis

##### **Frequency and venue of meetings**

In general, meetings will be held once every two months. However, the group shall meet at any time a majority of the members consider necessary. An indicative annual work plan shall be presented by the focal donor and approved at the end of each February. The location of a given meeting will depend on the number of participants and invitees.

##### **Secretariat**

The focal donor will take on the role of secretariat of the group. The secretary will issue invitations, circulate the preparatory documentation, and prepare and circulate the minutes of the meetings.
